

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FB R-1 HANDLES FOR VALVES SOLD WITHOUT HANDLE

To accommodate the new, improved Fine Blank (FB) R-1 handle, your valve must have the raised stop plate (part number 7-42-095) included in this kit.

- 1. If your valve has a $\frac{3}{16}$ " thick stop plate (part number 7-42-073 stamped on the face, remove and discard it.
- 2. Place the raised stop plate on the trunnion so that the stop plate ears contact the stops on the trunnion retaining plate.
- 3. Install the FB R-1 handle in the proper position on the trunnion and install the washer and bolt.
